- **"America the beautiful: Clyde Butcher's monumental photographs of the American landscape"**- The Everglades best kept secret is without a doubt Clyde Butcher. He is one of the best black and white landscape photographers in the world. His photographs show a beauty of the everglades that most tourists and even natives never see. His exhibit is open now until December 11 at the von Liebig Art Center. This event is strolling distance from the Lemon Tree Inn.
- **"Naples Collects"**- This exhibit features paintings, drawings, prints and sculpture borrowed from some of Naples' most prominent art collections. This is



a great opportunity to see the rare treasures that not many ever see. This exhibit is open now until January 25, 2009. It is located at the Naples Art Association at 585 Park Street, located just three blocks from Lemon Tree Inn.

- **"New Years Art Festival"**- This street festival on 5th Avenue, features fine art, food, live music and more on Saturday, Dec 27 and Sunday, December 28. paintings, drawings, prints and sculpture borrowed from some of Naples' most prominent art collections. The even is free and open to the public. Lemon Tree Inn guests can walk two blocks from the hotel to the art show.
